

French for Ministry Intensive

A Week-long Intensive Course in Montreal

Monday, May 6th to Friday, May 10th, 2024



The French for Ministry Intensive is designed for clergy, lay leaders, and spiritual care professionals looking to improve their ability to work in French. The course provides participants with the necessary vocabulary and grammar to enhance their French linguistic and communication skills for ministerial contexts. Activities include: learning church and ministry-specific vocabulary, writing prayers and theological reflections, and role playing pastoral care situations. Participants may take this course as part of the Certificate in Bilingual Ministry or as a stand-alone continuing education course.

Prospective students must:

1. Fill out the application form on the website (montrealdio.ca/courses/french-for-ministry)
2. Demonstrate at least an intermediate level of French on an oral and written French placement test
