Sunday School children

1. *What does it mean that God made every person “wonderful”?*
2. *Who helps you learn brave things at school or church?*
3. *How can we make sure everyone gets a turn to speak?*

Youth

1. *Where do you see people being left out of leadership—at school, online, or in faith spaces?*
2. *What helps someone grow confident when they’ve been told they don’t matter?*
3. *What does equality look like in real life—not just in words?*

Young adults

1. *How does “context” shape how we read scripture—and how we act?*
2. *What do you think it means to build leadership “across denominations”?*
3. *Where are you being invited to practice solidarity rather than charity?*

Adults

1. *Where might the church need to listen more deeply to women and Indigenous leaders?*
2. *What structures (spoken or unspoken) limit leadership in your community?*
3. *What would it mean for your congregation to accompany women-led justice work long-term?*
